



He served as a faculty member of Health Management Research Institute in Jeddah, Saudi Arabia. He has associated with various research organizations and infrastructure development institutions as consultant and advisor.

A study conducted to understand quality of care and patient satisfaction from primary healthcare in Benghazi city. Quality has been defined in this study as doing right things right in a right manner at the right time with a right mix of manpower, equipments, space and management systems and subsystems. Patient satisfaction, the result of quality of care is the comfort level of beneficiaries in terms of care and concern shown by the facility. Beneficiaries are highly satisfied with the quality of care received. Two major significant variables associated with satisfaction are age of patient and selection of facilities. Those in younger age are less satisfied than others. People seek facilities at different locations and reach better satisfaction levels. This study concludes that primary health care facilities are working well effectively. But the efficiency of the system might be of attention in the coming years. This might be made through manpower mix, skill upgradation, human resource development activities and so on. Facilities might also focus on patient satisfaction. Provisions are made to ensure satisfaction of users.



This book is the outcome of the academic contributions by seven researchers examined the various issues related to Ageing and/or elderly persons (60+ years) belonged to India and selected states / ruralurban settings. Though the focus is mainly on data published from Indian censuses, attempts are also being made by some researchers to analyse the data from large-scale as well as micro-level studies and the strength of this book lies in presenting multiplicity of ageing issues such as levels and trends in the growth of elderly, their economic activities and socioeconomic profile, disabilities and health problems, lifestyle habits, headship status, poverty conditions and policies & programmes for the elderly' welfare and highlights the situation of elderly in India, besides their needs, poverty and health conditions.

The world Health Report 2010 - Health Systems Financing: the Path to Universal Coverage

The World Health Report 2010 - Health systems financing: the path to universal coverage Good health is essential to human welfare and to sustained economic and social development. WHO's Member States have set themselves the target of developing their health financing systems to ensure that all people can use health services, while being protected against financial hardship associated with paying for them. In this report, the World Health Organization maps out what countries can do to modify their financing systems so they can move more quickly towards this goal universal coverage - and sustain the gains that

have been achieved The report builds on new research and lessons learnt from country experience. It provides an action agenda for countries at all stages of development and proposes ways that the international community can better support efforts in low



income countries to achieve universal coverage and improve health outcomes

MDG Report 2010 launched

The <u>Millennium Development Goals Report 2010</u> was launched in New York by the Secretary-General on 23 June 2010. The report, which presents the yearly assessment of global progress towards the MDGs, warns that while some progress has been made, it is uneven. And it pinpoints the areas where the accelerated efforts are needed to meet MDGs by 2015,is prepared by the Statistics Division of DESA on the basis of inputs provided by the members of the Inter-agency and Expert Group on MDG Indicators. Less than six years away from the 2015 deadline to achieve the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs), the report warns that despite many successes, overall progress has been too slow for most of the targets to be met by 2015. And major advances in the fight against poverty and hunger have begun to slow or even reverse as a result of the global economic and food crises. The <u>MDG Progress Chart 2009</u> provides an assessment of progress as of June 2009 towards a number of the key targets relating to each Goal.

The IPUMS International database has now integrated the 5th NSS schedule 10 sample, round 61 (2004/5). The Minnesota Population Center wishes to thank the National Sample Survey Organization for licensing the samples to the IPUMS International project for dissemination to bona fide researchers without cost. The complete database contains 159 samples, representing 55 countries and totals over 325 million integrated person records. At present 36 Indian researchers are registered. There were 734 downloads in the first year for the four schedule 10 samples (1983-1999). The table also lists the 33 most frequently accessed variables among all the samples in the database. You are invited to register to gain access to this treasure trove. Attached for your information is the brochure "Ten Tips" on how to construct parsimonious extracts of the samples, browse the metadata, download the micro-data, and analyze them with your favorite statistical package.
