Report of the Joint Workshop on “Quantitative Data Analyses using STATA”

Indian Association for Social Sciences and Health (IASSH) in collaboration with the G. B. Pant Social Science Institute, Jhusi, Prayagraj, organized a two-day training workshop on quantitative data analysis during 26th and 27th February 2024. The primary objective of this workshop was to equip early career researchers in the fields of social sciences and health studies with the essential skills and knowledge required for effective quantitative data analysis using the STATA software. The workshop aimed to bridge the gap between theoretical knowledge and practical application, empowering the participants to independently conduct robust data analysis for their research projects/Ph.D. work.

In the workshop, fifty participants, mostly PhD students from diverse disciplines of social sciences from different institutes such as IIT Roorkee, International Institute for Population Sciences, Mumbai, University of Lucknow, A. N. Sinha Institute of Social Studies, Alia University, University of Allahabad, Pondicherry University, and so on, attended, covering different states such as Delhi, Himachal Pradesh, Maharashtra, West Bengal, Madhya Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh, etc. For this workshop two resource persons, Dr. Rakesh Mishra and Dr. Mohammad Hifz Ur Rahman were invited to train the participants. In addition to these two resource persons, facilitators such as Dr. Manik Kumar and Mohammad Hammad were present for hands-on training during the workshop.

Before beginning the workshop, the study materials, sample data, and Stata code were shared among the participants for review. It helped the participants to familiarize themselves with the instructions during the workshop. The participants have learned the skills provided at the workshop. They found the workshop very useful for their research during Ph.D. and other research activities. The participants also recommended having such kind of workshops in the future with specific and advanced data analyses in the disciplines of social sciences.

The workshop was inaugurated by the Director of the Institute, Prof. Badri Narayan on February 26th, 2024. In the valedictory session on 27th February 2024, Prof. Manmohan Krishna, Department of Economics, University of Allahabad, talked about the importance of data analysis in social science research. Prof. T. V. Sekher (President, IASSH) also addressed the participants. Dr. Md. Juel Rana (Faculty, GBPSSI) coordinated the workshop.

Prof. K. Mahadevan Award for Best Publication - 2024

The Indian Association for Social Sciences and Health (IASSH) is a professional association of social scientists with more than 1300 life members (www.iassh.org). IASSH is happy to announce the competition for Prof. K. Mahadevan Award for Best Publication authored by young researchers on field based research. Prof. Mahadevan was a renowned anthropologist, demographer and author of many books and publications. To encourage field-based research, academic scholarship and scientific publications in social sciences and health studies, we invite applications from young researchers to submit their published journal articles for the consideration of the award.

Eligibility Criteria:

1. The applicant should be an Indian citizen and currently doing PhD or working in an Indian institution/university.
2. The paper should be fully-based on **field based research** conducted by the author/s.
3. Applicant should be below **35 years** of age as on **1st January 2024**.
4. The paper submitted for consideration of award should be published in a refereed academic journal in the **year 2023**.
5. The applicant should be the **single author/ first author** of the published paper.
6. The paper should broadly be dealing with social sciences and health issues.

The publications will be evaluated by an Expert Committee appointed by the IASSH. The author of the selected best publication will be awarded with a certificate and cash prize of Rs. 25,000.

The young researchers may submit the applications to the IASSH secretariat (e-mail: iassh2004@gmail.com) by **15 August 2024** by sending their Curriculum Vitae, Published Article and Date of Birth Certificate.

The winner of the award will be announced on our website in September 2024 (www.iassh.org) and will be invited to receive the award in the next Annual Conference of the IASSH.
